There are always more things happening at the Capitol that can be covered in a newsletter so I will try to hit some of the main points.

Education issues continue to be on the front burner. After the school choice bill passed, it should also be mentioned that we passed a 3% increase in State Supplemental Aid (SSA) for public schools this past week. Yes, we care about public schools.

On that note, I also attended a hearing this past week where several teachers shared their frustration regarding discipline problems and the lack of support from administrators in dealing with it. We heard stories of physical and sexual assault in the schools with nothing being done about it!

The teachers we heard from were also frustrated with some of the curriculum they are required to use that compounds the problems they are facing. Specifically mentioned was ESL (Emotional Social Learning), which may go by different names.
